Acadia (4235)

Acadia is an early season yellow intermediate variety that produces a large and attractive bronze globe. It has the characteristic Celebrate plant structure of a firm and upright plant with deep green leaves and a strong bolting tolerance. A high percentage of single centers and colossal size makes Acadia a good processing onion.

Disease Ratings: High Tolerance to Pink Root, Fusarium and Bolting.
